EMERGENCY FIRE AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon roads, trails, and general forest areas within the Umpqua National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning November 4, 2020 at 00:01 and ending December 15, 2020 unless rescinded sooner.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being upon a closed road. [36 CFR § 261.54 (e)]
2. Going into or being upon a closed area. [36 CFR § 261.52 (e)]
3. Being upon a closed trail. [36 CFR § 261.55(a)]

Closure Area is described as an area starting at the point where the Umpqua National Forest boundary intersects Forest Road 23 in T 25S R 1W Sec. 36 and continuing in a southeast direction along Forest Road 23 to the point Forest Road 23 junctions with Forest Road 38, then southwesterly along Forest Road 38 to the point it changes jurisdiction and becomes County Road 249, then continues southwesterly along County Road 249 to the junction of State Highway 138, following Highway 138 west to Steamboat Inn, at Steamboat Inn heading south across the North Umpqua River to Forest Service Trail 1414 (North Umpqua Trail), following trail 1414 east to the intersection of Forest Service Road 4712, following Forest Service Road 4712 to the south bank of the North Umpqua River, following the south bank of the North Umpqua River east to the junction of Forest Road 4714, then continuing southwest along Forest Road 4714 to the junction of Forest Road 4714-330, following Forest Road 4714-330 southwest to the intersection of Forest Road 4714-585, following 4714-585 northwest to the intersection of 4711-670, following 4711-670 southwest to the intersection of 4711-600, following 4711-600 west to the 4711-550, following the 4711-550 west to the Umpqua National Forest Boundary, following the Forest Boundary north and east back to the point of origin. The forest routes listed above that bound the closure area and all Forest Service lands, roads, and trails within the described closure are hereby made part of this closure order.

Exceptions to the closure:

Forest Road 23, Canton Creek Road will remain open to public travel.

Forest Road 38, Steamboat Road will remain open to public travel.


Forest Trail 1414 North Umpqua Trail, Mott Section, is open from Steamboat Inn east to the Mott Trailhead

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A. Executed in Roseburg, Oregon this 3rd day of November 2020.

This Order supersedes Order No. 06-15-06-20-425.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18 USC § 3571).
