EMERGENCY FIRE AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon roads, trails, and general forest areas within the Umpqua National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning November 5, 2020 at 00:01 and ending December 15, 2020 unless rescinded sooner.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being upon a closed road. [36 CFR § 261.54 (e)]
2. Going into or being upon a closed area. [36 CFR § 261.52 (e)]
3. Being upon a closed trail. [36 CFR § 261.55(a)]

Closure is described as an area starting at the point where Forest Service Road (FSR) 60 intersects Highway 138 in T27S R51/2 E Sec.6, continuing northeast on FSR 60 to the intersection of FSR 60-990, following FSR 60-990 northeast to the intersection of Thirsty Creek, following Thirsty Creek southeast to the intersection of the Mt. Thielsen Wilderness Boundary, following the Mt. Thielsen Wilderness Boundary southwest to the intersection of Forest Service Trail (FST) 1456 Mt. Thielsen Trail, following the FST 1456 southwest to the intersection of Highway 138, Following Highway 138 northwest to the intersection of FSR 4795, following FSR 4795 west to the intersection of FST 1452, following FST 1452 to the intersection of FST1452A, following 1452A northwest to the intersection of FSR 4790-400, following FSR 4790-400 north to the intersection of FSR 4790, following 4790 northeast to Highway 138, following Highway 138 southeast back to the point of origin. All Forest Service lands, roads, and trails within the described closure are hereby made part of this closure order. FSR 60, FSR 60-990, FSR 4795, FST 1456 (Mt Thielsen Trail) including the trailhead, and the Diamond Lake Viewpoint remain open. FSR 4790, FSR 4790-400, FST 1452, and FST 1452A remain closed.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A. Executed in Roseburg, Oregon this 4th day of November 2020.

This Order supersedes Order No. 06-15-03-20-427.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18USC § 3571).
